Faculty Compensation Model for Summer Teaching

General Information

Departments will be expected to offer the same suite of courses with the same anticipated enrollments in Summer Sessions I and II of the upcoming Summer Sessions as in the previous Summer I and Summer II sessions. We encourage departments to expand their summer school offerings if there are sufficient resources within their budgets to do so.

For nine-month and twelve-month faculty, the College of Sciences complies with university's regulation on additional compensation ([REG 05.58.01 Additional Compensation Paid through the University](#)). The College of Sciences Compensation Rate for On-campus Summer School Instruction

Compensation is provided by the departments for on-campus instruction. The standard compensation rate is 3.3 percent of an individual's full-time nine-month salary per credit hour taught. Departments, with approval of the Dean, may use a different compensation model than the standard model. Note that if departments wish to exceed the 3.3 percent per credit hour rate, there must be sufficient resources within the department's budget to do so.

Compensation for instructors who are not full-time faculty should be negotiated by the department head with the Dean on a case-by-case basis.

Compensation is not authorized for the supervision of summer graduate student research.
